
A Few Requests...

Tour Details:

Self-Guided (free)

The self-guided tour will allow you to tour the gardens at your own pace. Teachers will be provided with a pdf of information that could be included in your tour via email when a self-guided tour is booked. Self-guided tours are limited to 40 students per day. There must be at least one adult chaperon for every 10 students.

Guided Tours (\$5 per student)

An experienced guide will lead your group through the gardens to explore the various plants, trees and flowers giving plenty of opportunities for students to ask questions. The guided tour can also include a tour of The Farm at Rockledge Gardens, our hydroponic vegetable farm, where students can learn all about growing edibles in a unique and sustainable way. At the end of a guided tour, all students may plant their own flower or vegetable seed at our potting station to take home and watch grow! Guided tours are limited to 20 students per group (classes may be split up with half starting at The *Farm and the other half starting at the gardens* and then swapping to accommodate more students). We ask that there be a minumum of 10 students participating for a guided tour. There must be at least one adult chaperon for every 10 students. There is no charge for adult chaperons or teachers.
